AN ACT to amend the Dentists Act, 1939-1967.

[Assented to 8th December, 1970.]

 B^{E} it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

(1) This Act may be cited as the Dentists Act Short title and citation. Amendment Act, 1970.

- (2) In this Act the Dentists Act, 1939-1967, is ferred to as the principal Act.

 (2) The principal Act of smended by this Act by Act of the Act referred to as the principal Act.
- (3) The principal Act as amended by this Act by Act No. may be cited as the Dentists Act, 1939-1970.

Commencement. 2. This Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment to s.50. (Practice of dentistry by certain persons prohibited.).

3. Subsection (2) of section 50 of the principal Act is amended by adding after the word "give" being the last word in paragraph (d) a passage as follows—

"; or

(e) a student who, while undergoing instruction in a school of dental therapy that is approved by the Board, performs an act of dentistry under the direction of a dentist".
