

## DISTRICT COURT OF WESTERN AUSTRALIA (No. 2).

AN ACT to amend the District Court of Western  
Australia Act, 1969-1970.

[Assented to 8th December, 1970.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent  
Majesty, by and with the advice and consent  
of the Legislative Council and the Legislative  
Assembly of Western Australia, in this present  
Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:—

Short title  
and citation.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *District  
Court of Western Australia Act Amendment Act  
(No. 2), 1970.*

(2) In this Act the District Court of Western  
Australia Act, 1969-1970, is referred to as the  
principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act  
may be cited as the District Court of Western  
Australia Act, 1969-1970.

2. Subsection (1) of section 12 of the principal Act is amended—

- (a) by substituting for paragraph (a) a paragraph as follows—

- (a) to the Chairman, at the rate of seventeen thousand four hundred dollars a year; ; and

- (b) by substituting for paragraph (b) a paragraph as follows—

- (b) to each of the other District Court Judges, at the rate of sixteen thousand two hundred dollars a year, .

3. Subsection (2) of section 15 of the principal Act is amended by adding after the figures "1950" in the last line of the subsection the passage ", but the pension otherwise payable under that Act to and in relation to him, shall be reduced in accordance with the provisions of that Act by the amount of the State share of the first mentioned pension paid to and in relation to him".
