AN ACT to amend the Education Act, 1928-1969.

[Assented to 29th April, 1970.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Education Act Amendment Act, 1970*. Short title and citation.

(2) In this Act the Education Act, 1928-1969, is referred to as the principal Act. Reprinted in Vol. 16 of the Reprinted Acts approved for reprint 22nd Nov., 1962 and further amended by Acts Nos. 26 of 1964, 17 and 61 of 1965, 37 of 1966, 12 and 48 of 1967, 23 of 1968 and 91 of 1969.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Education Act, 1928-1970.
