No. 94 of 1970.

AN ACT to amend the Electoral Act, 1907-1970.

[Assented to 30th November, 1970.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Electoral Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1970.*

(2) In this Act the Electoral Act, 1907-1970, is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Electoral Act, 1907-1970.

2. This Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by proclamation.
