AN ACT to authorise the raising of a sum of Fifty-six Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars by loan for the construction of certain Public Works and for Other Purposes.

WHEREAS it is expedient to authorise the raising, by way of loan of certain sums of money amounting in all to fifty-six million two hundred thousand dollars for the several purposes hereinafter mentioned: Be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited for all purposes as the short title. Loan Act, 1970.

Power to raise money for certain purposes. 2. It shall be lawful for the Governor, from time to time, to raise by way of such loan several sums of money, not exceeding in the whole the sum of fifty-six million two hundred thousand dollars, as may be required for the several works and purposes mentioned in the First Schedule to this Act.

Sums raised, how to be applied. 3. All sums by this Act authorised to be raised shall be paid to the Treasurer, and shall be by him placed to the credit of an account, to be called the General Loan Fund, and shall be applied by the Treasurer to the purposes set forth in the said Schedule.

Principal and interest charged on Revenue.

4. The principal moneys, and interest thereon, raised under the authority of this Act shall rank pari passu with the principal moneys and interest raised and secured by the Stock created and sold under the Loan Act, 1891, and all subsequent Loan Acts, and are hereby charged upon and shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and Assets of the Government of Western Australia.

Advances on account.

5. The Governor may from time to time by warrant under his hand authorise the Treasurer to advance and apply to the purposes set forth in the First Schedule to this Act any sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum hereby authorised to be raised; and any sums of money so advanced and paid shall be retained by the Treasurer out of any moneys coming to his hands under the authority of this Act.

Reappropriation from and to. 6. It shall be lawful for the Governor to appropriate out of the sums set forth in the Second Schedule hereto, from the items therein set forth, and to the items enumerated in the Third Schedule hereto, the sum of one million nine hundred and forty-three thousand two hundred and three dollars to be expended on the works and purposes named in the Third Schedule hereto.
