AN ACT to amend the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1909-1970.

[Assented to 8th October, 1970.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:---

(1) This Act may be cited as the Metropolitan Short title and citation. 1. Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1970.

(2) In this Act the Metropolitan Water Supply, Reprinted as approved for reprint on 2115 Nov-Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1909-1970, is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1909-1970.

Amendment to s. 69A. (Power of Board to acquire sewers, etc. from a local authority.)

Amendment to s. 146. (Board may make by-laws.)

- 2. Section 69A of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by adding after the figures "1911" in the last line of subsection (1) the passage ", and the Board may so purchase any waterworks or water supply constructed and purchased or procured with money so borrowed and that are vested in the local authority";
 - (b) by adding after the word "sewerage" in line two of subsection (2) the words "or any waterworks or water supply"; and
 - (c) by adding after the word "constructed" in line two of paragraph (c) of subsection (2) the words "or procured".
- 3. Section 146 of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by adding after the section number "146." the subsection designation "(1)"; and
 - (b) by adding a subsection as follows-

(2) A by-law may be made under this section so as to require a matter affected by it to be in accordance with a specified standard or specified requirement; or as approved by, or to the satisfaction of, a specified person or body or class of person or body, and so as to delegate or to confer upon a specified person or body, or class of person or body, a discretionary authority.
