STATUTE LAW REVISION.

No. 10 of 1970.

AN ACT to revise the Statute Law by repealing spent, unnecessary or superseded enactments, to give short titles to certain Acts of Parliament and to amend the short titles of others.

[Assented to 29th April, 1970.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Statute Law Short title. Revision Act, 1970.
- The enactments mentioned in the First Repeal. Schedule to this Act are repealed.

Short titles provided.

3. The enactments mentioned in the first column of the Second Schedule to this Act and cited in the manner appearing in the second column of the Schedule are amended as provided, in each case, in the third column of the Schedule.

Short titles amended.

4. The Acts appearing in the Third Schedule to this Act and cited in the manner appearing in the second column of the Schedule may be cited (together with amendments, if any,) in the manner appearing, in each case, in the third column of the Schedule.
