

CONSTITUTION ACTS AMENDMENT.

No. 111 of 1969.

AN ACT to amend the Constitution Acts Amendment Act, 1899-1965.

[*Reserved 25th November, 1969.*]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Constitution Acts Amendment Act, 1969.*

(2) In this Act the Constitution Acts Amendment Act, 1899-1965, is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Constitution Acts Amendment Act, 1899-1969.

2. Paragraph (5) of section 38 of the principal Act is amended by substituting for the words "for two consecutive months of any session thereof" in lines three and four the words "for one entire session thereof" .

3. Schedule IV to the principal Act is amended by substituting for the passage—

"On and after the first day of September, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five, at the rate per annum of 14,500"

in lines two, three and four the passage—

"On and after the first day of October, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, at the rate per annum of 17,000".
