## AN ACT to amend the Forests Act, 1918-1964.

[Assented to 17th November, 1969.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Forests Act Amendment Act, 1969.

2. Subsection (2) of section 41 of the principal Amendment to s. 41.

(Nine-tenths) Act is amended of all

(a) by adding after the subsection designation be credited to a fund "(2)" the paragraph designation "(a)"; for reforestation.) and
